

Saw Operator Duties

The Saw Operator position will entail the following duties at a minimum:

- Have familiarity with band-saws as used in a job shop environment.
- It will be the operator's responsibility to maintain quality checks for jobs that have been set-up to run production.
- Must be able to read and interpret part drawings.
- Must be able to read and use inspection tools such as calipers and micrometers.
- Work with the Lead Saw Supervisor or Shop Forman to maintain quality issues affect part quality.
- Must have good communication skills (both listening and speaking clearly) in order to receive orders and instructions from the Production Scheduler.
- Must possess the ability to determine the best yield from the material in regards to the instructions on the job travelers.
- Work with quality department to verify quality.
- Have the ability to keep the machine operating to maintain estimated production benchmarks.
- To properly enter the appropriate data from the job travelers into the E2 ERP system.
- Must be able to maintain proper part counts while running jobs.
- Must be attentive and listen and follow instructions from the Shop Forman and Lead Saw Department supervisor.
- Have the ability to be able to lift 40lbs. consistently, with the occasional 70lbs. at any particular time.
- Use all safety lifting apparatus whenever is appropriate.
- Maintain a clean work area.
- Must follow and observe all company safety regulations and guidelines. Especially
 those that regard saw safety. The operator will be trained and must sign off on the
 training.
- Work towards obtaining the tools of the trade: Calipers, micrometers and wrenches.

- Must be certified to operate the powered lift trucks for material handling.
- Must be trained and follow the LOTO procedure that is used to change blades on the saw. The operator will sign off after they have been trained on this SOP.
